## Jewellery

- All earrings must be removed or taped up (only if piercing has recently been done and needs 6 weeks recovery).
- Watches must be removed
- No other jewellery should be worn at any time.

## Medication

• If your child requires medication in school such as an inhaler or an EpiPen, these must be handed in at the office (x2) to ensure there is one in the classroom to take to PE lessons and a spare at the office.

• Your child's teacher will keep the classroom medication in a designated area and will take it to each lesson.
