Please ensure you book your child's meal on Arbor each day as this helps them with their choices.

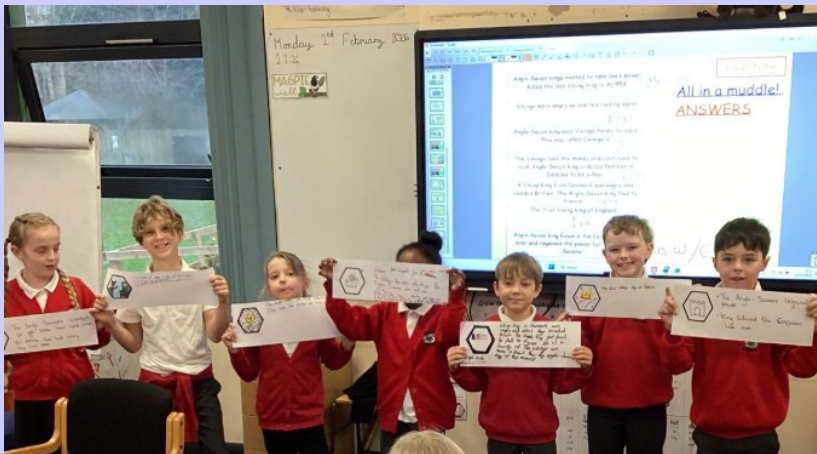
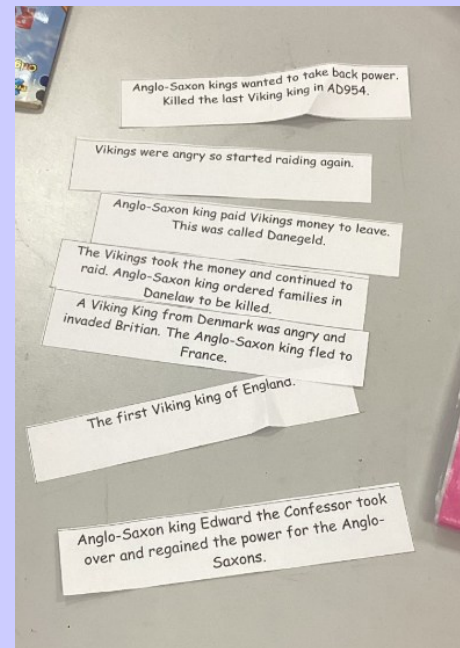

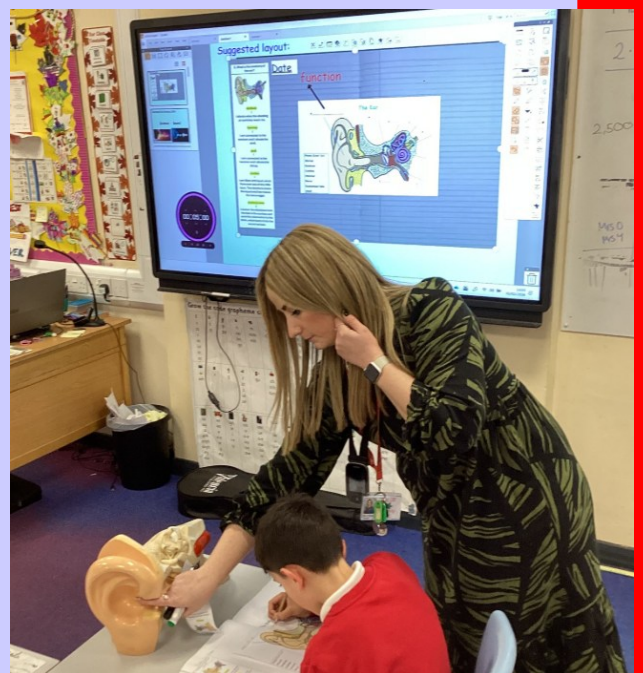
